Preparing for the future at Royds Hall Community School

We have shared a set of proposals for re-organising Royds Hall Community School into separate primary and secondary schools. We are also proposing to move all our primary children to one site. We are keen to hear parents' views before we make any decisions.

The changes, if agreed, will give all our primary children access to the first class facilities at Luck Lane, a new, purpose-built building. We know the journey might be inconvenient for some parents, so we are also proposing to provide a bus and breakfast to help. We can assure parents we will put the best interests of children first, whatever we decide to do.

Our proposals are also designed to cause the least possible disruption to other schools in the area.

We have seen comments from parents suggesting we will sell the land and the Trust will profit. Can we reassure everyone this is not the case? The decision about the land will be made by the Secretary of State for Education and SHARE Multi-Academy Trust will not gain financially from the land or buildings in any way.

The consultation runs until 27th June 2021 and we are keen to hear as many views as possible before deciding the next steps.
