



Home School Guide – Summer 2

Tiger Lillies – Years 3 and 4

English – For our fiction genre, we will be learning to write a journey tale – children will learn to use dialogue in a story. For non-fiction, we will be writing an explanation text. We will continue to develop our reading comprehension skills by reading a variety of texts including “The Butterfly Lion”, “The Battle of Bubble and Squeak” and “The Sheep Pig”. Children will learn to retrieve, compare, predict, infer, explain and find information.

Maths – In maths, we will consolidate our learning on number and place value as well addition and some subtraction, some of which was covered during remote learning. Our geometry unit will include learning about the properties of shapes, position, direction and motion.

Art – In our unit this half term, which is all about drawing, we will take inspiration from the artist, Katy Lipscomb. Children will learn to use different pencils to show line, tone and texture. They will use colour tones to create light and shadows and to create effects.

History – In history, we will be delving into the Anglo-Saxon age in Britain and discovering where it fits into a chronological time line. Children will learn who the Anglo-Saxons were, where they settled, how they ruled and how they influenced the present and future.

Science – In physics, we will continue our unit on sound in which children will identify how sounds are made. In addition, as part of our unit on forces and magnets, children will compare how things move on different surfaces and compare friction with magnetism.

PE – This half term in PE our topic will be Outdoor Adventurous Activities. Some of the key skills the children will develop include teamwork, trust, map reading and problem solving. PE will be on Wednesdays.

- PE is on a Wednesday this half term. All children should attend school in their PE kit. Please remove children’s jewellery in a morning if they cannot remove it on their own.
