Stargazers – Y4/5 Theme/Topic – The Yorkshire Coast

The Year 4/5 team are looking forward to seeing all the children again back in school for our final half term before summer! We will be learning all about The Yorkshire Coast and about erosion and deposition.

English – We will be continuing to use Talk 4 Writing to plan, innovate, develop and publish wonderful writing. In our fiction writing we will write a losing tale where our main character will lose something valuable or precious, and set out to find it or face with the consequences of losing it. In our non-fiction writing, we will be writing newspaper reports!

Maths – In maths we will continue to learn about decimals, as well as recap some of the objectives covered over the lockdown period. Times tables will continue to be a large focus throughout the year for both years 4 and 5 owing to the multiplication check for Y4 pupils, so practise at home would be appreciated.

Topic – In topic this half term we will become geographers as we study The Yorkshire Coast. We will become biologists in Science as we learn about living things. We'll be using the book Dear Zoo to help us learn the names of animals in French, and for PE this half term, we'll be doing rounders.
