### *Macmillan Bake Sale*

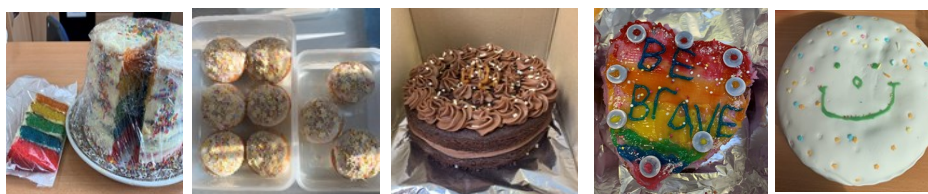

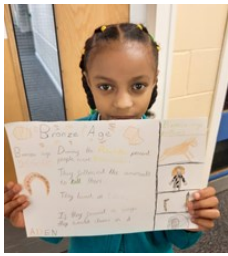

### Stargazers

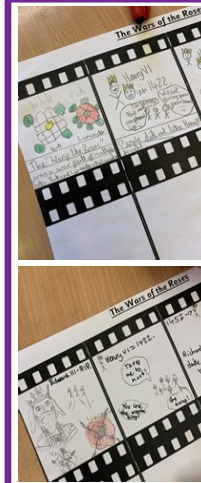

Even if your child is in Reception to Year 2 and receives Universal Free School Meals, you should apply.

#### DO YOU RECEIVE ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING?

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
- Income support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, but are not entitled to a Working Tax Credit and your annual income (as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs) is less than £16,100
- Support under Part V1 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
