### Tiny Bees

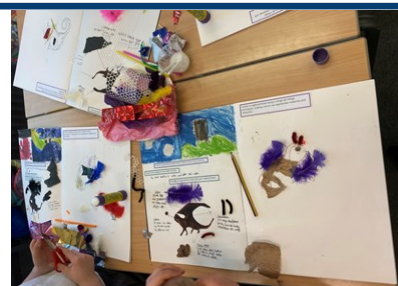
Tiny Bees have been learning about Autumn this week. In class we made some bird feeders to hang on the trees in our playground.
