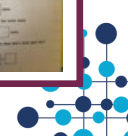
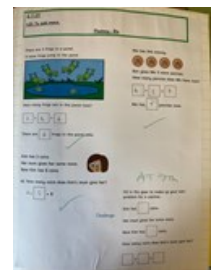
Tiny Bees

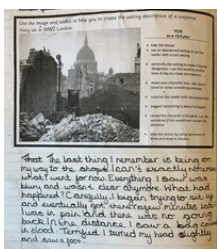
Tiger Lilies
