Tiny Bees went on a story stick walk to retell the story of 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt.' Luckily we found the bear hiding in our forest.

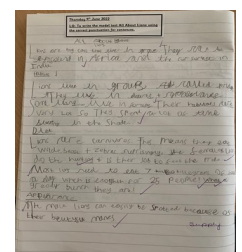

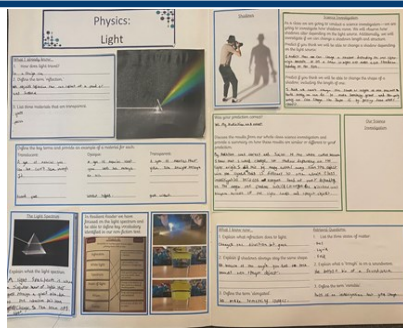
## Tiger Lilies
