Well done to everyone who has accessed their spelling on Spelling Shed this week. Our spelling bee's this week are



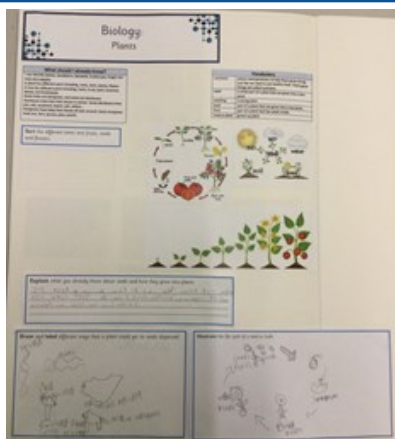

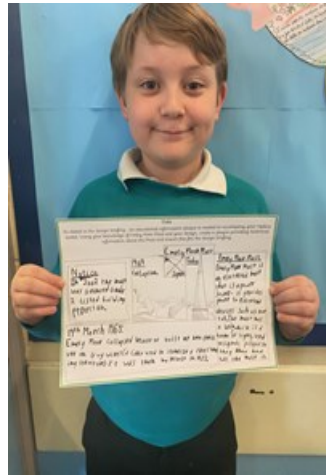
## Tiger Lilies
